LOCAL LAW NO. 1 — 1952

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A REVOLVING PETTY CASH FUND FOR THE SHERIFF OF ORLEANS COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF ORLEANS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to authority contained in Section 371 of the County Law, there is hereby established a revolving petty cash fund in the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, (\$400.00), for the Sheriff of Orleans County. Expenditures from this petty cash fund shall be made, and the said fund shall be used and administered in accordance with the provisions of Subd. 2 of Section 371 of the County Law.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Moved by Mr. Tucker, seconded by Mr. Hill, that the Secretary to the Bovine T.B. Committee, Mrs. Elizabeth Lee, be paid at the rate of \$1.00 per hr.
