

LOCAL LAW NO. 1, OF 1956
(Introductory No. 1 of 1956)

A local law to provide for continuation of Workmen's Compensation Mutual Plan, and the conversion thereof to a County Self-Insurance Plan, pursuant to Workmen's Compensation Law, Article 5.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Orleans as follows:

Section 1. The Workmen's Compensation Mutual Plan established pursuant to former Section 50 (3-a) of the Workmen's Compensation Law is hereby continued in existence through December 31, 1956, when it shall become the Orleans County Self-Insurance Plan.

Section 2. The governing board of each municipality participating in the present mutual plan shall by resolution signify its election to participate in the Orleans County Self-Insurance Plan. A certified copy of such resolution shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors by August 1, 1956.

Section 3. The Orleans County Self-Insurance Plan shall be administered by a committee appointed by the Board of Supervisors, which shall be the present insurance committee and is a standing committee of the Board of Supervisors. The insurance committee shall appoint an executive secretary and such other employees as it, from time to time, deems necessary, whose salary and expenses shall be payable from moneys of the plan, who shall keep the necessary records of the plan, attend hearings and transact such other business as shall be delegated to such officers and employees by the committee.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect July 10, 1956.
