SECTION 1. No mayor of any village, supervisor of any town, councilman of any town, or trustee of any village who resides in the County of Orleans shall be eligible to hold at the same time, the office of Orleans County Legislator at Large or County Legislator from any district within the County.

SECTION 2. This local law shall apply to any person hereinafter elected or appointed to the Orleans County Legislature.

SECTION 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
