Local Law No. 4 of the year 19 91

A local law Establishing Charges for Solid Waste Collection

SECTION I.

The Orleans County Legislature, in accordance with County Law, Section 226-b.(2), shall by Resolution, from time to time, after a public hearing, establish, amend and modify schedules of charges, rates or fees to be charged for solid waste collection and recycling program.

SECTION II.

Each tax map parcel within the County of Orleans, as designated by the Legislature to be eligible for solid waste collection, shall be subject to such charges, rates or fees. The Orleans County Treasurer is hereby authorized to place the charge, rate or fee so established by the Legislature for each said eligible parcel as a separate item on the real property tax bill levying the County tax for each such parcel. The County Treasurer may also collect such charges, rates or fees by a separate billing to each eligible tax map parcel. Such charges, rates or fees shall be due and payable as of the date of mailing of such tax bill or separate bill which is hereby fixed as the first day for payment of such charges.

SECTION III.

The County Treasurer shall collect and receive such charges, rates or fees in accordance with County Law, Section 266. Unpaid charges, rates or fees shall be a lien upon the real property subject to such charge as and from the first day fixed for payment of such charges.

SECTION IV.

Such charges, rates or fees remaining unpaid for thirty (30) days after the first day for payment thereof shall be subject to and shall have added thereto penalties and interest equal to those imposed and charged for the late payment of real property taxes as provided in the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York until such charges, rates or fees are paid or until the charge is levied by the Orleans County Legislature in accordance with the provisions of County Law Section 266.

SECTION V.

Appeals from any determination made under this Local Law shall be taken to the Orleans County Legislature by filing with the Clerk of the Legislature, a written request for an appeal hearing within twenty (20) days of the adverse determination. Such request for hearing shall specify the questioned determination, the date thereof and the basis upon which the appeal is taken stating specific reasons and facts which support the appeal. The appellant will be provided an opportunity to be heard by the Legislature and may submit evidence for consideration by the Legislature. The Legislature will issue a written decision on any such appeal.

SECTION VI.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
