Section 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS

The Orleans County Legislature finds that, at present, Orleans County maintains many miles of roads and/or highways. The County Highway Department removes debris and litter. As limited resources have compelled all levels of government to do more with less, road repair and safety tasks have taken priority.

Across our nation and throughout Western New York, private citizens and various community organizations have demonstrated their commitment to keeping America beautiful by "adopting" stretches of highway and pledging to assist government efforts to keep them litter-free.

Section 2. ESTABLISHMENT

The County Superintendent of Highways shall develop and implement an Adopt-A-Highway Program, the purpose of which shall be to reduce and remove litter and debris from county roads and highways. Such program shall include, but not be limited to:

(a) providing and coordinating services by volunteers or groups to reduce the amount of litter on county roads, including safety briefings, reflective safety gear, trash bags, and trash bag pickup on county roads and highways, and

(b) providing and installing road signs identifying those

volunteers or groups adopting particular segments of county roads or highways.

(c) entering into adopt-a-highway permit agreements with various groups for the purpose of delineating the responsibilities of the parties.

Section 3. ABSENCE OF COUNTY LIABILITY

Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of any law, the county and its employees shall not be liable for damages suffered by any person resulting from the actions or activities of such volunteers or groups.

Section 4. REGULATIONS

The County Superintendent of Highways shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement and carry out the provisions of this local law.

Section 5. PARTICIPATION

No group shall be authorized to participate in any of the activities hereunder without first executing an Adopt-A-Highway agreement.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately.
